- EDUC 1300 is required for all First Time in College (FTIC) students at HCC. If not FTIC, take HIST 2301 to prepare for the social studies content exam.
  PHYS 2325 will satisfy the Physical Lab Science elective in the AAT degree at HCC. This elective will transfer and apply to degree requirements at UHD.
  PSYC 2301 will satisfy the Social Behavioral Science core requirement in the AAT degree at HCC.
  Students who take three (3) Life and Physical Science Core Courses, in different content areas (BIOL. CHEM. PHYS with a grade of C or higher) as part of the AAT may transfer the third course in for NS 3310.

# Transfer of Credit & Student Benefits

- Credits from HCC that are transferrable to UHD degree programs may be specified in any program-to-program articulation agreement.
- Reverse transfer
- HCC students will be allowed access to academic advising services at UHD
- HCC Honors students admitted to UHD will receive:
  - Acceptance to UHD Honors Program with a minimum GPA (GPA varies by the College in which the program resides)
  - UHD will accept a minimum of 12 hours of transfer Honors credit; eligible for merit and need-based aid commensurate with qualifications

# Program Admission Requirements

(Associate of Arts in Teaching to Bachelor of Arts in Interdisciplinary Studies-EC-6 Special Education)

# Program Specific Requirements

- Transfer Admission Criteria (15 or more earned college-level credit hours) 2.0 GPA
- Student must be in Good Academic Standing at last institution attended
- For a course taken more than once, the highest grade will be transferred
- Students must earn a C or higher in ENG 1301 and ENG 1302; MATH 1301; Life and Physical Science component; and American History component
- Students must have a minimum 2.5 <u>overall</u> GPA to apply for admission to the Urban Education educator preparation program (this includes courses taken at the community college and at UHD).
- To become a certified teacher in Texas, one of the TExES certification exams a teacher candidate must pass is the Core Subjects EC-6. This exam requires sufficient knowledge in English Language Arts and Reading, Math, Science, Social Studies, and Fine Arts, PE & Health. You must retain the content from your HCC core classes as part of the foundation needed to pass the Core Subjects exam.
