#### Notes/Comments:

- (1) EDUC 1300 is required for First Time in College (FTIC) students only. If not FTIC, take SPCH 1311. Students who are FTIC are still required to complete SPCH 1311.
- (2) Students must take (2) Literature courses. Literature will satisfy Lang. Phil, & Culture core as well as 1 required literature. One course must be pre-1800 and one course must be post-1800.
- (3) Students must take Beginning I course and Beginning II course of the same language: ARAB, CHIN, FREN, GERM, ITAL, JAPN, SGNL, SPAN. Students fluent in a foreign language should consult with an advisor for testing alternatives.
- (4) Select from ENG 3330, 3331, 3332 3335, 4360, or 4381.
- (5) Free electives (lower level or upper level) must be taken to complete the minimum 120 hours required for the BSW degree at UHD; Students should consult with an advisor to select free electives at UHD and/or select a minor field of study; EDUC 1300 (if FTIC) will count toward the free elective requirements.

## Articulation Agreement Information – Standard and Program to Program (P2P)

### Transfer of Credit & Student Benefits

- Credits from LSC that are transferrable to UHD degree programs may be specified in any program-to-program articulation agreement.
- Reverse transfer
- LSC students will be allowed access to academic advising services at UHD
- LSC Honors students admitted to UHD will receive:
  - Acceptance to UHD Honors Program with a minimum GPA (GPA varies by the College in which the program resides)
  - UHD will accept a minimum of 12 hours of transfer Honors credit; eligible for merit and need-based aid commensurate with qualifications

### Program Admission Requirements
