- UHD Budgetary Status
- Please share when budget constraints first became an issue needing attention.
 - Shared Composite Financial Index (CFI)
 - Reviewed CFI Primary Reserve (35%) and CFI Operating Ratio (10%) from 2018 to 2024
 - Had an issue keeping our budget since 2018
 - During and after COVID we did a lot of online instruction and remote work, so costs at the university declined
 - We did receive federal dollars for COVID relief during that time, which helped balance our budget at the time due to the costs decrease and increase in federal dollars
 - Worked on retention in FY23 to address the issue with the budget
 - Credit hours dropped by 7.3% during Fall 2020 to Fall 2024 so less tuition and fee revenue
 - There was also a legislative session 88 during this period that determined our state appropriation. Our state appropriation and funding formula is based on enrollment so that negatively impacted our state appropriation.
 - Freeze on tuition and fee increases during FY 2023 and 2024
 - Inflation after COVID

- Last year worked on retention and enrollment because enrollment was flat for FY2024
- Also implemented budget reduction
- Strategic initiatives to increase enrollment by retention and recruitment
- Did a 3% budget reduction across all divisions
- Please share the status of our operating reserves.
 - Operating reserves are needed "rainy day" funds are for unanticipated events, short falls with revenue, or any strategic initiatives we want to put in place
 - Reserves at the university systems level recommend that we have at least 10% of our operating budget as reserves. This has been met
 - UHD decided to adopt and target the best practices of 4 months/16 weeks (about a semester) worth of operating expenses as reserves to have for any unexpected reasons we can still operate for a semester. We are not there yet but are working on it. We have met the minimum that the system requires but we have a new target we want to achieve that we believe would be in the best interest of the university
- What current and planned expenses have been reevaluated due to budget considerations? Negotiate for favorable rates to continue service, EI, Chartwells and custodial contracts.
 - The evaluation of budget is delegated to the senior leadership of the division or college.
 - Contracts and agreements are longtime fixed priced contracts so it is difficult to make changes with a contract already in place
 - We are in the process of going out for a new dining service vendor. We are doing the formal bid process this summer
 - \circ $\,$ We finished the custodial bid process last year $\,$
 - Part of the formal bid process is solicit bids from companies and one of the major criteria for evaluating bids is costs
- Were reductions evenly administered across campus departments?
 - Yes and no. 3% budget reductions were across all divisions but it was up to the senior leadership how those reductions were allocated across the departments
- When will budget line item reductions or eliminated be restored?
 - All budget reductions are permanent
 - But if we are fortunate from the state to receive additional revenue or enrollment goes up causing additional dollars to come through the door, then part of budget development process is for each individual department, division, college can submit budget requests for FY27 if you feel strongly about a budget line, service, etc. that needs to be restored

- Does attendance by community members for tabling events on campus generate enough income to offset the expenses incurred for them being here? i.e. electricity, parking, etc.
 - Yes, the university facility rental rate is a cost recovery rate meaning that charge external client that recovers all the infrastructure
 - Any service that is above normal operations they directly build the outside entity that is using our facilities
 - Update on FY2026 Preliminary Operating Budget
- Q&A
 - Where online can we review this operation budget information?
 - Once the budget is finalized and will go in front of the board of regions in August, it will be posted on the Budget Office website
 - Will the slides presented be available to the staff?
 - Yes, when we do our budget we put together a budget and executive summary which is what is presented to the board of regions which includes these details
 - Why didn't we cut more than 3%?
 - 3% was difficult and a lot. Taking it in phases. If we were to cut more it may be impactful to student success and possibly unfortunately result to RIFs. So much uncertainty from the state and enrollment so just taking it one step at a time and try not to make it too much of a negative impact to the institution
 - If remote work helped us cut costs, why are we eliminating that program?
 - Tabled
 - There were so many unnecessary expenses like the signage on top of OMB.
 - Operating budget is reoccurring dollars that come in every year such as tuition and fees, student appropriation, auxiliary dollars, etc. When we cut the budget, we cut those type of dollars. The sign or things that are one-time are not operating budget reoccurring items. Cannot hire a position with one-time dollars. The sign comes from one-time dollars that we would only use for things that are one-time and does not relate to reducing our operating/reoccurring dollars
 - Is staff reduction and or not filling open positions on the table to reduce the deficit? And or is this left up to departments heads?
 - Last year when we did our budget reduction exercise, we eliminated a lot of vacant positions. This time around

there are quite a few vacant positions that have been proposed to be eliminated. So yes, that is definitely one of those strategies.

- If student's can barely afford tuition, it's highly unlikely that they'd be able to afford housing.
- How cost effective is it to turn off the AC on weekends and have to blast it on Monday morning to cool the buldings back down? The buildings are HOT when we arrive on Monday mornings.
 - Tim Rychlec could answer, but over last 3 years seen a reduction in utilities consumption. Reason for that is having the automated system so we are reducing consumption even though we bought a new facility online. The system is working.
 - Debora Evans: I believe the A/C is on a reduced scheduled on the weekends.
- How can we reduce general supplies for operations if we are going through inflation?
 - Debora Evans: I have a table on the first floor where anyone can place unwanted office supplies free. Come check out the table, free stuff goes fast.
 - Majority of the items on the table are items from:
 - Staff leaving, retired and supplies not used anymore.
- But remote work relates HEAVILY to costs!!!!!
 - When I talked about remote work and online instruction during COVID, that was when no one was on campus so that is when the costs really declined. Costs were minimal, however the hybrid we have now might be different and I don't know how much cost saving that will bring. Can't really talk about that and I don't think there is a correlation between returning to the office and cost saving. I don't think that is the reason you are being asked to come back to campus.
- o or the concert and UHD magazines.
- o going through inflation as well as coming back full time
- o not making great sense
- Why are we removing phones? if we want everyone back on campus.
 - Charged IT to look into Zoom and Team phone instead of having a handset telephone on your desk. Just doing a quick analysis to see cost saving what does that mean. Right now there is a charge of \$40-45 to maintain each phone infrastructure and purchase. Is there a way for us to go to Zoom or Teams to save costs and be more efficient?

- o Nick Martinez: Have thought of outside the box options to increase revenue streams with lots of campuses and open area that can rent out for corporate events or functions. Are there packages together or campaign team committee to host varies events that staple the downtown Houston area.
 - Yes, we have we are going to be more robust in promoting our facilities to be used by external clients. But due to the Gator Expansion Project starting we put a hold on it since a lot of those spaces may not be available. The Washington Street parking lot will be park to pay for the weekends or evenings when UHD affiliates are not using it.
- Is GSB renovations scheduled to be in the fall a one-time or reoccurring cost?
 - It is a onetime cost and comes from the legislation session
- seems cost effective to KEEP hybrid in place

Bylaw Review (Spring 2025)



New Proposed Bylaw Received:

8. Staff Climate Survey (Adopted 5/20/25)

The Staff Climate Survey shall assess staff satisfaction, engagement, workplace culture, and other relevant factors that contribute to the overall staff experience. UHD Staff Council shall ensure the survey is designed to capture actionable data and feedback in an anonymous, inclusive, and equitable manner. Development of the survey shall be a collaborative effort with Human Resources and Institutional Effectiveness. UHD Staff Council shall make recommendations for addressing key findings and areas for improvement based on survey results. All survey results shall be shared with the University community at-large. UHD Staff Council will also facilitate follow-up communication regarding the actions taken in response to the survey results.

Proposed Amendment to Section 4: Duties and Responsibilities

Add the following line as a responsibility of Staff Council:

- Administering the Staff Climate Survey on every odd-numbered year. (Adopted 5/20/25)
